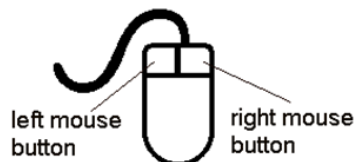

How to Use the Mouse

If you know how to use a mouse, please select the **Next** button to proceed.

Navigation buttons and functions on the computer screen can be selected by either using the mouse or the keyboard. A mouse looks like this:



The mouse can be moved by resting your hand on the mouse and sliding it slowly on the mouse pad. Slide the mouse left or right with its buttons facing away from you. Notice what happens to the arrow on the screen when you move the mouse. If you run out of room on the mouse pad, lift the mouse and move it back to the center of the mouse pad. Practice moving the pointer around on the screen and pointing to each of the navigation buttons on the bottom of the screen.

To select a navigation button, slide the mouse on the mouse pad until the pointer is directly over the button along the bottom edge of the screen. Then gently press and release the LEFT mouse button.



Use your mouse now to select the **Next** button to proceed to the next screen.

Time and Progress

At any point in the exam, you can see how much time you have remaining in the upper corner of the screen. Just below the time remaining, you will see your progress through the exam. For example, "4 of 8" indicates that you are viewing the fourth of eight questions or screens.



You can minimize the time remaining and the question number reminders by selecting them. During the exam, when you have five minutes remaining, the time remaining will automatically reappear. To restore them at any point, select on the icons  and .

Navigation

Next moves you from screen to screen.

Previous moves you back one screen.

The navigation buttons and functions can be selected by:

- Selecting the appropriate button with the mouse.

Using the Scrollbar

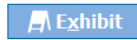
Some exam items may not fit on the screen. For these items, a scrollbar will appear along the portion of the screen that can be scrolled. To reveal the rest of the item, either use the mouse to select and drag the scrollbars, or select on the arrows on either end of the scrollbar.

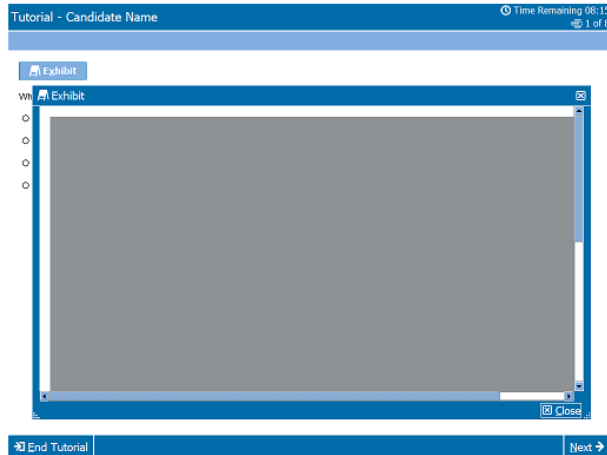

Viewing Exhibits

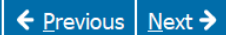
All items which show an image will also display an "Exhibit" button towards the top left hand side of the screen. When selected, a new window will appear showing an enlarged version of the image.



Some Exhibit windows may also display scrollbars within them. These are navigated using the same method as stated on the previous screen.

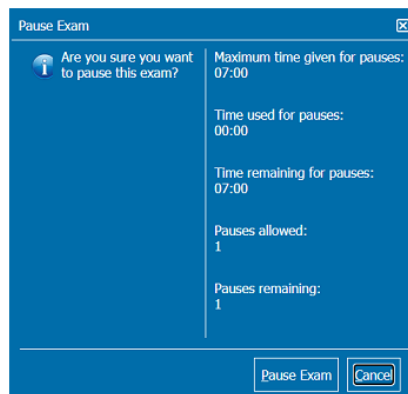


Pausing Exam (Break)

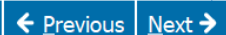
Please note: this break is only available to be used once during the entire exam. Once initiated it cannot be used again, even if the entire 7mins was not used, any remaining time from the break will be forfeited for the remainder of the exam. If your break exceeds the 7mins provided, any excess time will be deducted from the remaining exam time.

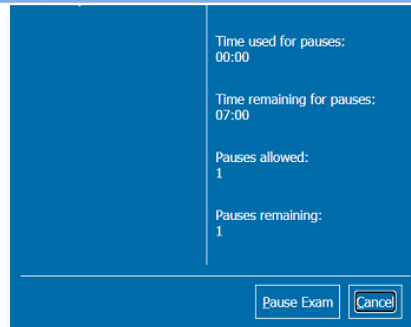
Throughout the exam the  **Pause Exam** button will be present. Please select this button in order to take a 7min break at any point.

Once selected a confirmation screen will be presented which must be confirmed in order to begin the break:

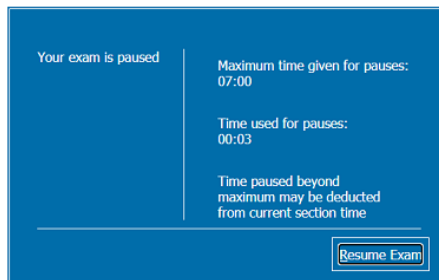


Once this has been confirmed the break will begin. The break screen will be displayed as such:



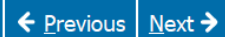


Once this has been confirmed the break will begin. The break screen will be displayed as such:



The "Resume Exam" button will take you back to the exam.

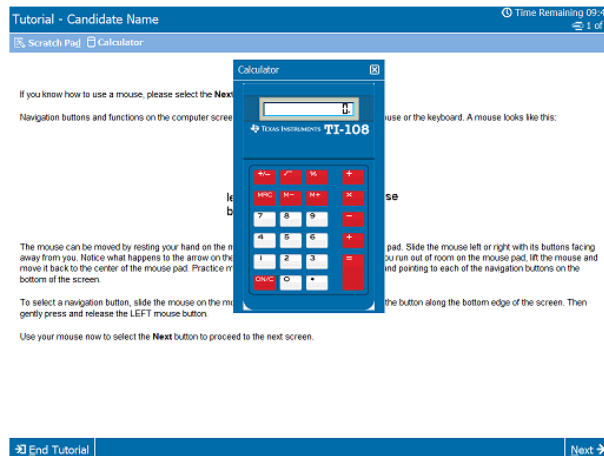

Calculator

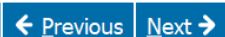
Calculator

The exam includes the use of a calculator which can be accessed by selecting the **Calculator** button from the bar located at the top of the screen. Once selected the Calculator will appear as shown below.




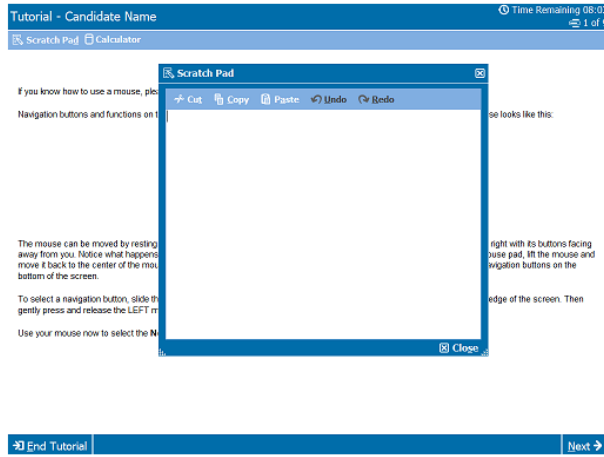
You may press the Calculator button on screen now to test this.

Scratch Pad

The exam includes the use of a Scratch Pad which can be accessed by selecting the  button from the bar located at the top of the screen. Once selected the Scratch Pad will appear as shown below.



The Scratch Pad can be used to make notes in order to aid answering questions during the exam. You may press the Scratch Pad button on screen now to test this.

Flag for Review

Your exam allows you to flag items that you want to return to later. To flag an item, select the button in the upper corner labeled **Flag for Review**. If you flag an item for review, a flag will appear next to that item on the review screen.



Review of items must be done during the testing time. You can select items for review whether you have answered them or not.

To flag an item for review:

- Use the mouse to move the pointer to the **Flag for Review** button and then select the LEFT mouse button.

A flag image will appear within the flag outline when the item has been flagged for review. If you wish to unflag the item, select the **Flag for Review** button again and the flag image will disappear.

When you reach the last question, press the **Next** button to move to the Review Screen.

Using the Review Screen

When item review is allowed, the Review Screen is automatically displayed at the end of the section.

If you checked the **Flag for Review** button on an Item Screen, a flag appears beside that item on the Review Screen. Unanswered items are displayed as "Incomplete."

From the Review Screen you can review items in a number of ways. The following buttons are available on the Review screen:

Instructions Select to view instructions on how to navigate the review screen.

Review All Select to review all the items and answers in the section.

Review Incomplete Review only the items that were left incomplete.

Review Flagged Review the items that are flagged for review.

You can select or deselect additional items to be flagged by selecting on the flag outline besides the item number.

If your exam has item review, a **Review Screen** button may appear on each screen of the section in review mode. When this button is provided you can access the Review Screen at any time during the section.




